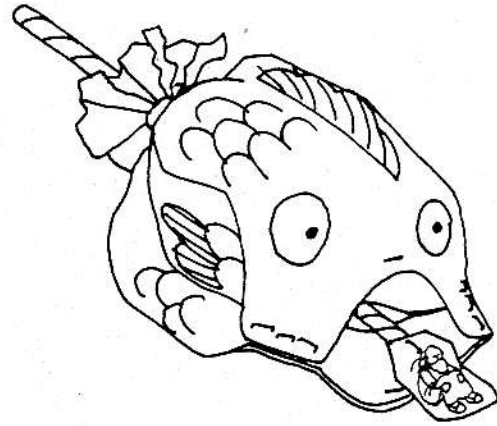


JONAH IN THE WHALE

What You Need:

small paper bag
2 plastic straws
3 paper napkins
wire twist
construction paper
markers or paint
stapler, scissors, tape



What You Do:

1. Staple the bottom corners of the bag together to form a mouth. Cut a slit in the middle of the mouth. Staple the sides together to keep the mouth open.

2. Cut one straw end at an angle and insert it into the other straw. Tape the straws together where they join.

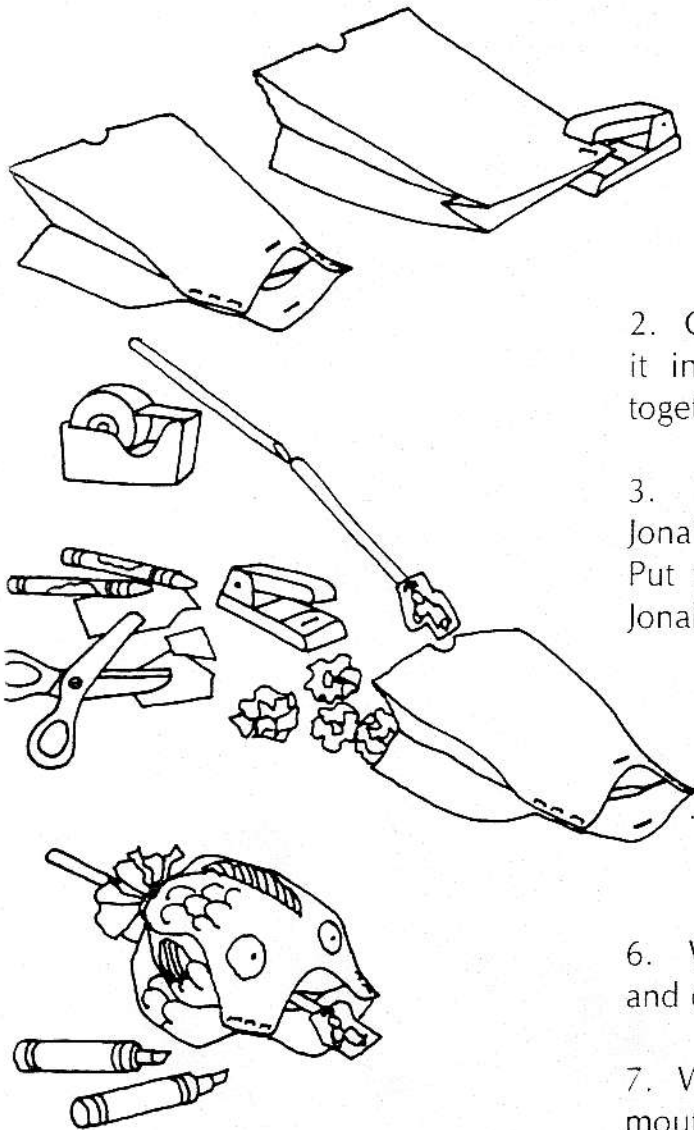
3. Draw and cut out a small picture of Jonah. Staple it onto one end of the straw. Put the straw into the bag. The end with Jonah on it should be near the mouth.

4. Crush the napkins into balls and stuff them inside the bag.

5. Close the bag around the straw and secure with wire twists.

6. With paint or markers, color the whale and draw eyes, mouth, flippers, and tail.

7. Watch Jonah go in and out of the whale's mouth as you move the straw.
